



Residential Water Heater Rebate Program

Qualifications for Rebate:

1. Buy an electric water heater that is greater than 90% efficient (greater than 0.90 EF) from the supplier of your choice.
2. Install the water heater in a residential home owned by the member and served by Carroll Electric.
3. Present the paid receipt to Carroll Electric and schedule an appointment to have a radio control switch installed or an existing switch inspected. The radio control switch should remain installed for a minimum of five (5) years.
4. Proof of purchase (receipt), including warranty information, must be received within 90 days of installation, contingent upon the existence of the statewide rebate program.
5. Once the radio control switch is installed and inspected, a check in the qualifying amount will be sent to you.

Rebates for Existing Homes: (with electric water heaters)

<u>Warranty</u>	<u>Capacity 50-70 Gallons</u>	<u>Capacity Over 70 Gallons</u>
5-10 years	\$75.00	\$100.00
11 years or more	\$125.00	\$200.00

Rebates for New Homes or Gas Conversions:

<u>Warranty</u>	<u>Capacity 50 Gallons or larger</u>
Minimum 5 years	\$200.00

(REBATES DO NOT APPLY TO SEASONAL ACCOUNTS)

The following conditions must be met for rebates to be paid:

- Tank must have a minimum of a 5-year warranty
- Minimum 50-gallon capacity
- All water heaters to receive rebate must have a radio control switch installed and inspected before rebate will be paid
- Under no circumstances will the rebate amount exceed the purchase price of the tank

The following exclusions apply:

- Hybrid Heat Pump Water Heaters and on-demand water heaters do not qualify for the Water Heater Rebate Program.
- Members are limited to one rebate per home.
