

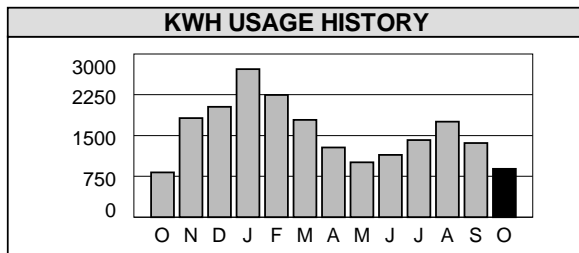

In this example, the member used 890 kWh in 29 days. The energy charge is \$133.50. This number can be deceiving, because it also contains the service availability charge. See the breakdown below to understand how your energy charge is calculated. Keep in mind that generation, transmission and distribution charges are all included in the energy charge. Other utilities may break out these three charges. At first glance it appears that our per kWh is higher, but in reality it may be the same or, in many cases, less than a neighboring utility.

Our cost is \$0.12695 per kWh for the first 100 kWh. The next 900 kWh are calculated at \$0.10765 and any kWh over 1,000 cost \$0.10465 per kWh. The more kWh you use the less expensive they become. Just remember that this per kWh charge includes generation at \$0.07, transmission, and distribution costs. See our residential billing rates at www.cecpower.coop.

The Power Cost Adjustment is a surcharge added to your electric bill each month based on the price we pay for electricity. Many factors affect the price of electricity at any given time. We utilize the Power Cost Adjustment to assess the overages (of \$0.07) to each member based on the number of kWh used each month. *When the power cost is lower than the \$0.07 charged to members the power cost adjustment appears as a negative number.*
