# **Children of Members Scholarship Program**

### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of our scholarship competition is to encourage our young people to further their education. Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. Judges reserve the right to award an additional \$1,000 to an exceptional student.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

To be eligible for the Carroll Electric Scholarship Awards, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applications:

1. Applicants must be a son, daughter, or legal ward of a Carroll Electric Cooperative, Inc. member living on the lines and receiving service at the time of competition.
2. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper vocational or technical school entrance. (A “proper vocational or technical school” is defined as a post-secondary institution where credits can be transferred to a state accredited four-year college.)
3. Applicants must have a current career average of 3.5 or above on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale. Winners, in order to receive an award must be accepted and then enrolled when they receive the award in an accredited college or proper vocational/technical school of student’s choice. Applicants, who are accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible.
4. Members of the immediate families and persons residing in the households of trustees, managers, or employees of Carroll Electric are not eligible to participate in this competition.



5. Applications for the Carroll Electric competition must be submitted (typed to be accepted) on the forms provided by Carroll Electric or downloaded from <http://www.cecpower.coop>. The application forms must be returned to the co-op office by **February 1** of the current year.

Application information must be confined to the official nomination form with no attachments other than grade transcripts. (Teacher recommendations must be no more than one paragraph.)

6. Applicants who have received “full ride” scholarships (tuition, room, board and books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible for scholarships from Carroll Electric.
7. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year after proof of enrollment is received. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause in the judgment of the CEO of Carroll Electric. In the event a student is unable to fulfill his enrollment obligation under this program, the award is forfeited.
8. Personal interviews may be conducted with qualifying applicants. The applicants will receive points for scholastic record, personal achievement, school and community activities. Points will also be awarded for poise, personality and appearance in the interview.  
*Finalists are not permitted to bring any outside materials to their interviews (electronic presentations, props, handouts, etc.).*
9. Winners will be notified as soon as possible after judging. *One winner will be chosen to represent Carroll Electric in the statewide scholarship competition where he or she will compete for additional scholarships. Eligibility requirements apply. Contact the cooperative for details.*
